_____	<b>HB 183</b>	<b>HONORE</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Provides for the use of body cameras by law enforcement officers
_____	<b>HB 209</b>	<b>LANDRY, T.</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the assessment of certain court costs and fees in parishes that participate in a criminalistics laboratory commission or a sheriff's criminalistics laboratory
_____	<b>HB 281</b>	<b>HILL</b>	<b>INSURANCE/GROUP-SHERIFFS</b> Provides relative to the payment of group insurance premiums for retired sheriffs and deputy sheriffs hired on or after July 1, 2015, for Allen Parish
_____	<b>HB 293</b>	<b>BARRAS</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Requires the supreme court to establish and maintain a website to post information concerning certain contracts
_____	<b>HB 294</b>	<b>BISHOP, S.</b>	<b>JUDGES</b> Requires personal financial disclosure by judges and justices of the peace
_____	<b>HB 371</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Reduces the amount of the per diem DPS&C pays to sheriffs for housing state inmates

_____	<b>HB 380</b>	<b>HOLLIS</b>	<b>SALES/TOBACCO DEALERS</b> Requires cigarettes to be stamped prior to selling or distribution
_____	<b>HB 392</b>	<b>LOPINTO</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Creates a database for certain training and hiring information for all law enforcement officers
_____	<b>HB 467</b>	<b>HARRIS</b>	<b>TOBACCO/TOBACCO PRODUCTS</b> Provides relative to the payment and purchase of tobacco products
_____	<b>HB 477</b>	<b>MONTOUCET</b>	<b>TOBACCO/TOBACCO PRODUCTS</b> Provides for minimum pricing of cigarettes
_____	<b>HB 605</b>	<b>SEABAUGH</b>	<b>INDIGENT DEFENSE</b> Provides relative to indigent defender services in capital cases
_____	<b>HB 627</b>	<b>BARROW</b>	<b>CORONERS</b> Provides relative to services provided by coroners
_____	<b>HB 698</b>	<b>ABRAMSON</b>	<b>BUDGETARY PROCEDURES</b> Requires the judiciary to prepare an annual financial report
_____	<b>HB 732</b>	<b>HUVAL</b>	<b>CORONERS</b> Authorizes a declaration of final disposition of human remains
_____	<b>HB 780</b>	<b>JAMES</b>	<b>COURTS/COURT COSTS</b> Authorizes a fee increase in recording fees for the East Baton Rouge Parish Clerk of Court
_____	<b>SB 37</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Requires the Council on Peace Officer Standards and Training to develop and continuously update certain training programs for peace officers and college or university police officers. (gov sig)
