_____	<b>HB 761</b>	<b>STOKES</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides relative to the Medicaid recovery audit contractor program
_____	<b>HB 790</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides for implementation of a Medicaid managed long term services and supports system

_____	<b>HB 946</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>PHYSICIANS</b> Provides relative to the investigation and adjudication of complaints against physicians
_____	<b>HB 980</b>	<b>BROADWATER</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides relative to the medical assistance program of the state

_____	<b>HB 995</b>	<b>JONES</b>	<b>WATER/DRINKING WATER</b> Increases the safe drinking water administration fee
_____	<b>HB 1007</b>	<b>MORENO</b>	<b>DRUGS</b> Provides relative to the storing and dispensing of naloxone and other opioid antagonists
_____	<b>HB 1029</b>	<b>MONTOUCET</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Authorizes the assessment of a provider fee on Medicaid managed care organizations
_____	<b>HB 1054</b>	<b>HUNTER</b>	<b>DRUGS/CONTROLLED</b> Provides relative to prescribing of controlled dangerous substances
_____	<b>HB 1112</b>	<b>JAMES</b>	<b>DRUGS/CONTROLLED</b> Establishes the Louisiana Therapeutic Use of Cannabis Act
_____	<b>HCR 77</b>	<b>MONTOUCET</b>	<b>HEALTH/DHH</b> Directs the Dept. of Health and Hospitals to evaluate and report on prospective models for improving care management in the Bayou Health program
