_____	HB 143	RICHARD	STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP Eliminates nomination by legislators of students for free tuition to Tulane University and granting of such free tuition
_____	HB 157	GAINES	PUBLIC RECORDS Authorizes the assessment of a civil penalty not to exceed \$100 per day for arbitrarily or capriciously withholding a record
_____	HB 231	THIBAUT	ETHICS/CODE Allows the immediate family member of a mayor or governing authority member of a municipality with a population of five thousand or less or a legal entity in which the family member has an interest to enter into a transaction with the municipality subject to certain conditions
_____	HB 272	HOLLIS	ELECTIONS/RECALL Provides relative to recall elections
_____	HB 279	JORDAN	PUBLIC OFFICIALS Prohibits interference with the recording of public officials and employees acting in an official capacity, with certain exceptions
_____	HB 383	BILLIOT	ETHICS/CODE Allows a former member of the board of commissioners of a fire protection district to contract with, be employed by, or be appointed to a position by

the board of commissioners after a period of six months after termination of his service
