_____	HB 61	FOIL	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides for the issuance of summons for misdemeanors or for certain felony charges
_____	HB 101	LANDRY, T.	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Eliminates the death penalty for offenses committed on or after August 1, 2017
