_____	HB 81	SMITH, P.	DOMESTIC ABUSE Provides relative to battery of a dating partner, domestic abuse, and uniform abuse prevention orders
_____	HB 162	LANDRY, T.	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Eliminates the death penalty for offenses committed on or after August 1, 2018
_____	HB 207	BAGLEY	DOMESTIC ABUSE Requires those who serve temporary protective orders or protective orders to transmit a service return to the Louisiana Protective Order Registry
_____	HB 236	IVEY	PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECTIONS Enacts the Inmate Rehabilitation and Computer Technology Development Act
_____	HB 310	TALBOT	GAMBLING (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to referendum elections on a proposition to allow new forms of gaming, gambling, or wagering
_____	HB 389	CARTER, G.	CRIME/SEX OFFENSES Increases penalties for the crime of sexual assault of persons with infirmities and provides enhanced penalties under certain circumstances

_____	HB 484	TALBOT	GAMING Provides for a proposition election to authorize fantasy sports contests in Louisiana
_____	HB 486	SHADOIN	JUVENILE PROCEDURE Provides relative to juvenile court jurisdiction
_____	HB 488	AMEDEE	CHILDREN/ABUSE Provides relative to the mandatory reporting of certain crimes of sexual abuse of a minor
_____	HB 612	STOKES	CRIME Provides relative to the observation or filming of a person and the disclosure of certain images of a person
_____	HB 776	SMITH, P.	CRIME Prohibits the possession of firearms in certain cases involving stalking
