_____	<b>HB 575</b>	<b>NORTON</b>	<b>CURRICULA</b> Relative to safety, provides for instruction in public schools and public postsecondary education institutions, provides for reporting online content to school and campus security officers and local law enforcement agencies
_____	<b>HB 587</b>	<b>HOFFMANN</b>	<b>TEACHERS</b> Provides relative to teacher tenure
_____	<b>HB 616</b>	<b>HILFERTY</b>	<b>SCHOOLS/FOOD PROGRAMS</b> Provides relative to foods and beverages, other than school breakfast or lunch, offered in public schools
_____	<b>HB 651</b>	<b>HOFFMANN</b>	<b>TEACHERS/EVALUATION</b> Reduces the percentage of a teacher's evaluation that is based on growth in student achievement
_____	<b>HB 707</b>	<b>JENKINS</b>	<b>TEACHERS</b> Revises processes for disciplinary action against nontenured and tenured teachers
_____	<b>HB 755</b>	<b>MILLER, D.</b>	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Authorizes each public and nonpublic school governing authority to adopt a policy relative to the supply and administration of naloxone and other opioid antagonists
