_____	HB 628	HUNTER	VOTERS/VOTING Provides for automatic voter registration through driver's license facilities and removes the age limit for a child to accompany a parent or guardian into the voting machine
_____	HB 649	GAINES	VOTING/REGISTRATION Provides for automatic voter registration through driver's license facilities
_____	HB 693	NORTON	SCHOOLS/BOARDS Creates a legislative advisory task force on conducting of school board meetings
_____	HB 733	BILLIOT	PUBLIC MEETINGS Prohibits video and audio recordings of hearings by the Board of Pardons and committee on parole
_____	HB 738	HUNTER	ETHICS/CODE Provides an ethics exception to allow legislators, statewide elected officials, specified public servants, immediate family members, and related legal entities to enter into contracts to be a public defender
