_____	<b>HB 253</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/HABIT OFFENDERS</b> Provides relative to the application of the habitual offender law
_____	<b>HB 259</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>BAIL</b> Provides for presumptive pretrial release of a defendant on an unsecured personal surety or bail without surety except under certain circumstances
_____	<b>HB 278</b>	<b>MARINO</b>	<b>PROBATION</b> Provides relative to the Swift and Certain Probation Pilot Program
_____	<b>HB 354</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/JURY TRIALS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to a unanimous jury in felony cases
_____	<b>HB 365</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/JURY TRIALS</b> Provides relative to a unanimous jury in felony cases
_____	<b>HB 389</b>	<b>CARTER, G.</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Increases penalties for the crime of sexual assault of persons with infirmities and provides enhanced penalties under certain circumstances
_____	<b>HB 438</b>	<b>PUGH</b>	<b>GAMBLING/RIVERBOAT</b> Provides for a referendum election in Tangipahoa Parish regarding riverboat gaming

_____	<b>HB 602</b>	<b>MIGUEZ</b>	<b>WEAPONS/FIREARMS</b> Provides relative to the carrying of a concealed handgun at a school
_____	<b>HB 761</b>	<b>PIERRE</b>	<b>CRIME/FELONIES</b> Amends criminal penalties for the crime of armed robbery
_____	<b>HB 762</b>	<b>HILFERTY</b>	<b>HOMELAND SECURITY</b> Provides relative to persons convicted of certain terrorism offenses
_____	<b>HB 807</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to probation and parole violations
_____	<b>SCR 6</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL RECORDS</b> Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to study and make recommendations relative to expungement fees.
_____	<b>SB 49</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES</b> Provides for family member visitation with offenders who have sustained serious injuries while in custody. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 50</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Adds a person's telephone number when used for "caller ID spoofing" to the definition of "personal identifying information" for purposes of the crime of identity theft. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 101</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL JUSTICE</b> Creates the Louisiana Sexual Assault Oversight Commission. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 102</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CHILDREN'S CODE</b> Provides relative to disposition of children after adjudication of certain felony-grade delinquent acts. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 105</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides that a person cannot give consent to sexual conduct while in police custody. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 166</b>	<b>THOMPSON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Requires the National Human Trafficking Resource Center hotline information to be posted in additional locations. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 231</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>WEAPONS</b> Provides relative to the transfer of firearms for the violation of a protective order. (10/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 236</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Creates the crime of sexual abuse of an animal. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 243</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Constitutional amendment to require unanimous juries for felonies. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
_____	<b>SB 441</b>	<b>MORRELL</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Provides penalties for reckless operation of certain all-terrain vehicles on public roadways. (8/1/18)
