_____	<b>HB 129</b>	<b>REYNOLDS</b>	<b>WILDLIFE &amp; FISHERIES</b> Exempts certain Department of Wildlife and Fisheries projects from the capital outlay process
_____	<b>HB 132</b>	<b>ZERINGUE</b>	<b>CAPITAL OUTLAY</b> Provides relative to the local match requirements for non-state entities applying for capital outlay funding
