_____	<b>HB 420</b>	<b>MILLER, D.</b>	<b>ETHICS/CODE</b> Provides relative to the Governmental Ethics exceptions for certain physicians
_____	<b>HB 89</b>	<b>SMITH, P.</b>	<b>REAPPORTIONMENT</b> Provides relative to the allocation of incarcerated persons for the purposes of all redistricting by the legislature
_____	<b>HB 99</b>	<b>JACKSON</b>	<b>CENSUS</b> Provides for the Louisiana Complete Count Committee
_____	<b>HB 123</b>	<b>GAROFALO</b>	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Prohibits a public body or official from filing suit against a person who has made a public records request
_____	<b>HB 255</b>	<b>FALCONER</b>	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Provides for a public records exception for certain records of the State Board of Architectural Examiners concerning the fitness of a person to receive or hold a license or certificate of registration to practice architecture
_____	<b>HB 269</b>	<b>FALCONER</b>	<b>DISTRICT ATTORNEYS</b> Provides for reproduction of public records from district attorney's offices
_____	<b>HB 270</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Exempts specified personally identifying information related to reports of violations of student codes of conduct or other policies intended for the safety of students or employees of

postsecondary education institutions from the Public Records Law

_____	<b>HB 297</b>	<b>BISHOP, S.</b>	<b>PUBLIC MEETINGS</b> Relative to special notice provisions for meetings of local governments involving changes to ad valorem or sales and use taxes
_____	<b>HB 189</b>	<b>WRIGHT</b>	<b>ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE</b> Provides for processes, including agency review and public comment, to identify agency rules that may be contrary to law, outdated, unnecessary, overly complex, or burdensome
_____	<b>HB 373</b>	<b>JOHNSON</b>	<b>ADMINISTRATIVE LAW</b> Provides relative to judicial review of certain administrative decisions
_____	<b>HB 615</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>INSURANCE</b> Provides relative to administrative hearings involving actions of the commissioner of insurance
_____	<b>HB 453</b>	<b>IVEY</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE POWERS</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Requires that any law enacted concerning a sales and use tax exemption or exclusion shall be uniformly applicable to the sales and use taxes of all taxing authorities in the state
