_____	HB 145	COX	MENTAL HEALTH Provides limitations on diagnosing of the disorder commonly known as "Munchausen syndrome by proxy", and on initiation of child welfare proceedings
_____	HB 158	FOIL	CORONERS Provides relative to admissions to treatment facilities under an emergency certificate
_____	HB 281	MORENO	NURSING HOMES Authorizes nursing home residents or their qualified surrogates to have monitoring devices installed in those residents' rooms
_____	HB 334	BACALA	MEDICAID Provides for implementation of a Medicaid managed long-term services and supports system
_____	HB 336	COX	MEDICAID Provides for a single preferred drug list in Medicaid managed care
_____	HB 461	TALBOT	MEDICAID Provides relative to Medicaid financing of nursing home care
_____	HB 492	BAGLEY	PHARMACISTS Requires that pharmacists report to certain parties when refills of certain psychiatric medications go undispensed
