_____	HB 256	MORRIS, JIM	TAX/SEVERANCE TAX Provides with respect to the rate and exemption for the severance tax on oil produced from incapable wells
_____	HB 331	LEGER	TAX CREDITS Changes the sound recording investment credit to a refundable tax credit and authorizes an additional base investment tax credit for resident copyrighted sound recordings
_____	HB 473	GLOVER	TAX CREDITS Adds certain investments by businesses issuing life insurance policies to investments eligible for the insurance premium tax credit
