_____	HB 62	CARTER, S.	SCHOOLS (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for appropriations from the Education Excellence Fund for certain schools
_____	HB 76	ABRAHAM	TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION (Constitutional Amendment) Establishes an ad valorem tax exemption for property subject to a cooperative endeavor agreement requiring the property owner to make payments in lieu of taxes
_____	HB 151	ZERINGUE	TAX/INCOME TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the rates and brackets for purposes of calculating income taxes and repeals the deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of computing individual and corporate income taxes
_____	HB 234	MIGUEZ	TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION (Constitutional Amendment) Extends the ad valorem tax exemption for raw materials, goods, commodities, and other property to property destined for the Outer Continental Shelf
_____	HB 260	STOKES	TAX/INCOME TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of calculating individual and corporate income taxes and requires the levy of a flat individual income tax rate
_____	HB 291	BARRAS	FUNDS/FUNDING (Constitutional Amendment) Dedication of unclaimed property funds and creation of Louisiana Unclaimed Property Permanent Trust Fund

and Louisiana Unclaimed Property Support Fund

_____	HB 346	HORTON	CIVIL SERVICE (Constitutional Amendment) Provides relative to the political activity restrictions applicable to classified employees of a fire and police civil service system
_____	HB 363	MARINO	CHILDREN/SUPPORT Provides relative to the payment of child support during incarceration
_____	HB 435	LANDRY, T.	LEGISLATORS (Constitutional Amendment) Provides that the legislature shall provide by law for an independent compensation commission to examine, evaluate, and establish the compensation, benefits, and expense allowances for members of the legislature
_____	HB 440	IVEY	TAX/AD VALOREM-EXEMPTION (Constitutional Amendment) Provides with respect to the ad valorem property tax exemption for certain manufacturers
_____	HB 441	IVEY	TAX/INCOME TAX (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for a flat tax on individual income and eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of computing individual, estate and trust, and corporate income taxes
_____	HB 515	GAROFALO	LIABILITY Provides relative to suits against the state and state officials and employees
_____	SB 71	CARTER, T.	CIVIL PROCEDURE Provides relative to interpreters for non-English-speaking persons in civil protective order cases.
_____	SB 106	LAMBERT	ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY Authorizes liens against certain immovable property for monies expended from the Hazardous Waste Site Cleanup Fund.
_____	SB 191	CHABERT	REAL ESTATE Provides actions for damages against real estate appraisers, appraisal management companies, and real estate appraisal companies.
