_____	<b>HCR 34</b>	<b>DAVIS</b>	<b>CHILDREN/NEWBORNS</b> Provides for the potential addition of mucopolysaccharidosis type I and Pompe disease to the state's newborn screening panel
_____	<b>HB 108</b>	<b>PYLANT</b>	<b>CHILDREN/NEWBORNS</b> Authorizes the installation and use of newborn safety devices at infant relinquishment sites designated in the Safe Haven Law
_____	<b>HB 129</b>	<b>CARMODY</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides relative to Medicaid nonemergency transportation providers and services
_____	<b>HB 207</b>	<b>AMEDEE</b>	<b>HEALTH SERVICES</b> Requires the provision of certain information to patients or parents of patients prior to administration of an immunization or a vaccine
_____	<b>HB 211</b>	<b>HORTON</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Provides relative to Medicaid coverage of certain behavioral health services
_____	<b>HB 390</b>	<b>WHITE, MALINDA</b>	<b>MEDICAID</b> Relative to reimbursement rates paid to providers of disability services
_____	<b>HB 427</b>	<b>SMITH, P.</b>	<b>EXCEPTIONAL PERSONS</b> Provides for communication-related services for the deaf and hard of hearing in certain healthcare settings

_____	<b>HB 433</b>	<b>LEBAS</b>	<b>PHARMACISTS</b> Authorizes a pharmacist to decline to dispense a covered prescription drug if the coverage provider reimburses the pharmacy in an amount less than the drug's acquisition cost
_____	<b>HB 475</b>	<b>MORRIS, JIM</b>	<b>HEALTH CARE/FACILITIES</b> Provides to the transferring management of the John J. Hainkel, Jr., Home and Rehabilitation Center from the Department of Health to the health care division of Louisiana State University
_____	<b>HB 535</b>	<b>GLOVER</b>	<b>DENTISTRY</b> Allows nonprofit entities the ability to perform dental services at mobile dental clinics
_____	<b>HB 538</b>	<b>LEBAS</b>	<b>PHARMACISTS</b> Provides relative to pharmacy record audits
_____	<b>HB 568</b>	<b>MILLER, D.</b>	<b>DRUGS/CONTROLLED</b> Provides that the regulation of therapeutic cannabis be placed under the authority of the Louisiana Department of Health
