 SB 273	HEWITT	<b>INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY</b> Provides for registration with secretary of state by managed service providers servicing public bodies. (See Act)
 SB 345	JOHNS	<b>CONTRACTS</b> Provides relative to noncompete agreements. (8/1/20)

 SB 406	MIZELL	<b>TELECOMMUNICATIONS</b> Provides for rural access to broadband high-speed internet service. (8/1/20)
