_____	<b>HB 576</b>	<b>WILLARD</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Provides with respect to maintaining voter registration lists
_____	<b>SB 36</b>	<b>BERNARD</b>	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Provides for the acceptance of a notice of candidacy. (gov sig)
_____	<b>SB 140</b>	<b>REESE</b>	<b>INTERNET</b> Requires certain offices to report cyber incidents to secretary of state. (8/1/20)
_____	<b>SB 173</b>	<b>BERNARD</b>	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Requires a notice to be posted upon the withdrawal or disqualification of a candidate's name that remains on the ballot. (8/1/20)
_____	<b>HB 784</b>	<b>MCCORMICK</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOS</b> Provides relative to certain types of contributions and records required to be maintained relative thereto
_____	<b>HB 866</b>	<b>CORMIER</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Prohibits the receipt of certain things of economic value by certain persons affiliated with a political subdivision's official journal and related persons subdivision
_____	<b>SB 155</b>	<b>LUNEAU</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides for payment of supplemental compensation from nonpublic sources for certain personnel at the Jimmy D. Long, Sr. Louisiana School for Math, Science, and the Arts. (8/1/20)

_____	<b>HB 188</b>	<b>GOUDEAU</b>	<b>CIVIL SERVICE</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for an exception to the prohibition on political activity by members of civil service systems
_____	<b>HB 633</b>	<b>FREIBERG</b>	<b>STATE EMPLOYEES</b> Provides for the mandatory training in cybersecurity awareness for all state and local employees, officials, and contractors
_____	<b>HR 13</b>	<b>MILLER, G.</b>	<b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Provides relative to House Legislative Services employees and duties of the Clerk of the House
_____	<b>HR 18</b>	<b>BACALA</b>	<b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Provides an option in the House Rules to limit the debate on legislative instruments on final passage or adoption by a majority vote of the elected members of the House
_____	<b>HR 45</b>	<b>DEVILLIER</b>	<b>BOARDS/COMMISSIONS</b> Directs state agencies and licensing boards to suspend the imposition of sanctions against licensees and permittees for a violation of COVID-19 executive orders
_____	<b>HCR 3</b>	<b>MAGEE</b>	<b>BOARDS/COMMISSIONS</b> Recreates the Louisiana Commission on Justice System Funding
_____	<b>HCR 29</b>	<b>JAMES</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/RECORDS</b> Creates the Clean Slate Task Force
_____	<b>SCR 27</b>	<b>HENRY, CAMERON</b>	<b>LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS</b> Requests a joint study of the ability of members of the legislature to vote by video or other electronic means.
