 HB 443	BEAULLIEU	TAX/INCOME-CREDIT Provides for individual income tax credits for donations made to school tuition organizations
 HB 503	CORMIER	TAX CREDITS Provides for a refundable individual income tax credit for residents of parishes that contain certain toll bridges
 HB 539	CORMIER	TAX Imposes a tax on the transmission of certain money and creates a special fund for the disposition of the avails of the tax
 HB 562	BOURRIAQUE	TAX APPEALS/BOARD Provides relative to the Louisiana Uniform Local Sales Tax Board and the Louisiana Sales and Use Tax Commission for Remote Sellers
 HB 573	STEFANSKI	TAX COMMISSION, STATE Provides for the administration, review, and adjudication of ad valorem tax assessments
 HB 659	WILLARD	TAX/INCOME-CREDIT Establishes an income tax credit for taxpayers claiming a dependent less than eighteen years of age
 HB 660	HUGHES	TAX CREDITS Increases the amount of the earned income tax credit for certain taxpayers for a specific period of time
