 HB7	FREEMAN	<b>TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT</b> Provides for a sales and use tax exemption for feminine hygiene products and diapers
 HB 30	DEVILLIER	<b>TAX/SEVERANCE TAX</b> Reduces the severance tax rate for oil over a certain period of time and fixes the severance tax rate for oil produced from certain wells at the current rate
 HB 57	COUSSAN	<b>TAX/SEVERANCE-EXEMPTION</b> Exempts oil production of certain oil wells from severance tax
 HB 131	COUSSAN	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Establishes an income tax credit for donations of property used for research or direct education of students to certain educational institutions
 HB 160	DEVILLIER	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Provides for the eligibility for the Angel Investor Tax Credit Program
 HB 252	LANDRY	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Exempts certain beverages from state excise tax
 HB 301	LANDRY	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Establishes an income tax credit for certain funeral and burial expenses for certain pregnancy-related deaths

 HB 429	GEYMANN	<b>TAX/SALES-USE-EXEMPT</b> Exempts certain sales made by schools from state and local sales and use tax
 HB 525	HARRIS, LANCE	<b>TAX/TOBACCO TAX</b> Excludes certain products from the excise tax levied on tobacco
 HB 567	JORDAN	<b>TAX/EXCISE</b> Repeals the marijuana tax levied on certain dealers and repeals provisions related to tax stamps which evidence payment of tax
 HB 582	MCFARLAND	<b>TAX/GASOLINE TAX</b> Repeals the existing tax on gasoline, diesel, and special fuels and levies a new tax on these motor fuels and an annual tax on electric and hybrid vehicles
 HB 592	HILFERTY	<b>TAX/INCOME TAX</b> Establishes an income tax deduction for certain early childhood care and education expenses
 HB 613	ROMERO	<b>TAX/AD VALOREM TAX</b> Provides for the determination of fair market value for purposes of ad valorem property taxation
 HB 658	COUSSAN	<b>TAX/SEVERANCE-EXEMPTION</b> Exempts oil production of newly completed wells that are undergoing or have undergone certain well enhancements
 HB 661	COUSSAN	<b>TAX/SEVERANCE-EXEMPTION</b> Exempts oil production of certain newly drilled wells from severance tax
 HB 662	COUSSAN	<b>TAX/SEVERANCE-EXEMPTION</b> Exempts oil production of certain orphaned wells from severance tax
