_____	HB 95	JOHNSON, MIKE	PUBLIC MEETINGS Provides for the use of a consent agenda by certain school boards and parish governing authorities
_____	HB 103	JOHNSON, MIKE	PUBLIC MEETINGS Requires certain public bodies to broadcast meetings live via television or the internet
_____	HB 105	TARVER, PHILLIP	ETHICS/CODE Allows a public servant and related persons to obtain advertisements from a governmental entity subject to the same terms and conditions available to similarly situated members of the public
_____	HB 110	OWEN, CHARLES	ETHICS Allows certain persons to know who filed an ethics complaint at the conclusion of board action on complaint

_____	HB 268	JOHNSON, MIKE	PUBLIC RECORDS Provides relative to the confidentiality of the home address and the home or personal wireless telephone number in a public employee's personnel
_____	HB 426	MELERINE	ETHICS/CODE Provides relative to educational professionals providing academic tutoring services under certain circumstances
_____	HB 499	BILLINGS	ELECTIONS/ABSENTEE VOTE Provides relative to the preparation, verification, tabulation, and counting of absentee by mail and early voting ballots
