- HR 12 FREEMAN** **CORRECTIONS** Continues the task force created by House Resolution No. 174 of the 2023 R.S. to study the educational programs in the prisons and jails of this state
- HCR 22 MARCELLE** **PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECTIONS** Directs the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to establish family-sensitive policies for all correctional facilities under the jurisdiction of the department
- HCR 24 MARCELLE** **PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECTIONS** Directs the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to permit incarcerated parents to virtually attend certain ceremonies involving their children
- HB 125 BAYHAM (TBA)** **CRIMINAL/PENALTIES** Provides relative to the penalties for battery of a bus operator (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- HB 127 BAYHAM (TBA)** **CRIMINAL/PENALTIES** Provides relative to the penalties for the crime of simple obstruction of a highway of commerce (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
- HB 165 BOYD** **CRIME** Provides relative to marijuana paraphernalia
- HB 166 BOYD** **CRIME/SEX OFFENSES** Provides relative to penalties for a person convicted of a sex offense
- HB 206 VILLIO** **CRIMINAL/MENTAL CAPACITY** Provides relative to the commitment of certain persons who are found not guilty by reason of insanity
- HB 355 GALLE** **CRIME** Amends provisions of law regarding justification in the use of force or violence
- HB 436 FREEMAN** **CRIME** Provides relative to intentional exposure to HIV
- HB 705 JORDAN** **CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS** Provides relative to payphones and communications for incarcerated individuals

CRIMINAL/VICTIMS Provides relative to victim notification

HB 735 KERNER

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES Provides relative to penalties for distribution or possession with intent to distribute certain controlled dangerous substances

HB 779 BOYD

CRIME/SEX OFFENSES Provides relative to the definition of "commercial sexual activity" within the crime of trafficking of children for sexual purposes

HB 816 CARTER, WILFORD (TBA)

CRIME Provides relative to residential contractor fraud (**Subject to Rule Suspension**)
