 HB 317	SCHAMERHORN	<b>MOTOR VEHICLES</b> Removes the helmet requirement for certain motorcycle operators
 HB 458	FONTENOT	<b>WILDLIFE &amp; FISHERIES</b> Provides relative to the regulation window tinting for patrol vehicles owned by the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries
 HB 490	BAYHAM	<b>TRAFFIC/VIOLATIONS</b> Prohibits the imposition of penalties for speeding in a school zone if signage is not posted at the entrance and exit
 HB 539	BOYER	<b>TRAFFIC/VIOLATIONS</b> Provides relative to pedestrians walking on highways during certain periods of the day
 HB 542	COX	<b>MTR VEHICLE/VIOLATIONS</b> Provides for increased penalties for certain traffic- control signal violations
