_____	<b>HB 119</b>	<b>DESHOTEL</b>	<b>MOTOR VEHICLES</b> Decreases the minimum light transmission percentage allowable for the front side window tint of motor vehicles
_____	<b>HB 170</b>	<b>COX</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/COMMERCIAL</b> Removes the requirement that taxi cab drivers obtain a chauffeur's license
_____	<b>HB 221</b>	<b>BAGLEY</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/INSPECTION</b> Provides relative to a motor vehicle inspection tax
_____	<b>HB 232</b>	<b>BAGLEY</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/INSPECTION</b> Eliminates the state inspection sticker requirement for certain vehicles

_____	<b>HB 519</b>	<b>GLORIOSO</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/VIOLATIONS</b> Provides relative to the operation of a motor vehicle while using a wireless telecommunication device
_____	<b>HB 554</b>	<b>MCKIN</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC</b> Establishes a notice of voting restriction and a restriction code applicable to persons who are not United States citizens and aliens lawfully present in the United States but have not attained United States citizenship
_____	<b>HB 630</b>	<b>BAYHAM</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC</b> Reduces the fee applicable to updating a driver's license to comply with REAL ID standards
