_____	<b>HR 244</b>	<b>FREIBERG</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR</b> Requests the legislative auditor to provide information relative to the Louisiana Commission on Justice System Funding
_____	<b>HB 215</b>	<b>BOYD</b>	<b>ABORTION</b> Provides for exceptions to the abortion laws of this state relative to rape and certain sex offenses
_____	<b>HB 244</b>	<b>KERNER</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Provides relative to electronic monitoring
_____	<b>HB 650</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>TAX/GAMING</b> Increases the state tax levied on certain gaming and dedicates the proceeds of the tax for certain purposes
_____	<b>SB 128</b>	<b>CARTER, GARY</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Requires a written report when any law enforcement officer uses force on a member of the public
