 HB 2	EMERSON	<b>CAPITAL OUTLAY</b> Provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget
 HB 3	EMERSON	CAPITAL OUTLAY Provides for the Omnibus Bond Act
HB 127	TARVER, PHILLIP	TAX/INCOME TAX Establishes an individual income tax deduction for contributions made into certain deductible savings accounts
 HB 145	WILDER	TAX/INCOME TAX Increases the maximum amount of the construction code retrofitting deduction and expands the deduction to cover costs associated with "fortified home" standards compliance
