 HB 624	BERAULT	<b>WORKFORCE COMMISSION</b> Transfers certain family and support programs from the Department of Children and Family Services to the Louisiana Workforce Commission and renames Louisiana Workforce Commission to Louisiana Works
 HB 663	FIRMENT	<b>TAX/INSURANCE PREMIUM</b> Provides for the disposition of certain state sales and use tax collections for the purpose of fortifying residential roofs in the coastal zone
