HB 361	LANDRY, TERRY JR	VOTING/REGISTRATION Provides for the reinstatement of the voter registration of a person who is no longer under an order of imprisonment
HB 459	LANDRY, MANDIE	ELECTIONS/CANDIDATES Provides relative to the use of artificial intelligence in political campaigns
HB 540	KNOX	ELECTION OFFENSES Provides for disclosures required in certain digital political communications
HB 615	JOHNSON, MIKE	PUBLIC MEETINGS Requires certain public meetings to be broadcast live
HB 627	KNOX	PUBLIC MEETINGS Provides relative to live-stream video and recording of the public meetings of entities created by law
