INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HR 38</b>	<b>OWEN, CHARLES</b>	<b>CONGRESS</b> Memorializes Congress to reform the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act and the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court and to restore the rights of privacy and protection against unreasonable searches and seizures
<b>HR 96</b>	<b>LYONS</b>	<b>CIVIL/PROCEDURE</b> Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to study current practices regarding the recall of civil bench warrants and the notification process in judgment debtor proceedings
<b>HCR 31</b>	<b>DOMANGUE</b>	<b>COMMERCE</b> Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study the use and application of the term "foreign" with respect to juridical persons provided for in state law
<b>HB 578</b>	<b>JOHNSON, MIKE</b>	<b>CIVIL/LAW</b> Provides for the Restoring Biological Truth Act
<b>HB 1198</b>	<b>AMEDEE</b>	<b>CHILDREN/CUSTODY</b> Prohibits relative to child custody
<b>SCR 19</b>	<b>MILLER, G.</b>	<b>TRUSTS</b> Requests the Louisiana State Law Institute to study the use of trusts with extended durations and report its findings and any recommendations for revisions to the Louisiana Trust Code and applicable Louisiana laws to the legislature.
<b>SB 66</b>	<b>HODGES</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides for testimony of medical experts in child custody and in need of care cases. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 68</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Constitutional amendment to provide for jurisdiction of the Louisiana Supreme Court. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
<b>SB 76</b>	<b>MILLER, G.</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Provides relative to the modification of child custody. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 77</b>	<b>MILLER, G.</b>	<b>LEASES</b> Provides for effects of leases of movable property. (8/1/26)

<b>SB 139</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>SUITS AGAINST STATE</b> Provides for the amount of interest awarded on claims for personal injury or wrongful death in suits against the state or political subdivisions. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 336</b>	<b>LUNEAU</b>	<b>CIVIL PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to civil investigative demands. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 475</b>	<b>MILLER, G.</b>	<b>CIVIL PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to fees for service of process. (8/1/26)
