**INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:**

<b>SB 1</b>	<b>JENKINS</b>	<b>PUBLIC MEETINGS</b> Provides for electronic voting requirements under the Open Meetings Law. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 41</b>	<b>ALLAIN</b>	<b>PUBLIC MEETINGS</b> Expands the number of days required for public bodies to publish minutes for open meetings from twenty days to forty-five days. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 47</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Requires certain email and telephone contact information for individual members of a board and commission. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 106</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Provides that certain photographs, audio or video recordings, digital images regarding a crime scene or used in a criminal prosecution are not public records available for release or to be copied except by clerk of court or a court order. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 210</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for the increase in the number of election commissioners for closed party primaries. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 218</b>	<b>TALBOT</b>	<b>ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for certification programs for election officials. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 220</b>	<b>TALBOT</b>	<b>OFFICIAL JOURNALS</b> Provides for the Official Journal of the State. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 248</b>	<b>MILLER, G.</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Provides for consolidation of precincts with fewer than 20 voters. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 289</b>	<b>ABRAHAM</b>	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Provides for confidentiality of certain information in public records requests for universities. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 397</b>	<b>REESE</b>	<b>ELECTED OFFICIALS</b> Provides for vacancies caused by retirement, resignation, or removal from elected office. (8/1/26)

Any interested person or any committee member may file with the committee a prepared statement concerning a specific instrument or matter under consideration by the committee or concerning any matter within the committee's scope of authority, and the committee records shall reflect receipt of such statement and the date and time thereof.
