HB 178	MUSCARELLO	COURTS/COURT REPORTERS Provides relative to discretionary transcription of certain criminal court proceedings
HB 179	MUSCARELLO	COURTS/COURT REPORTERS Provides relative to the retention of notes and recordings of court reporters
HB 187	MUSCARELLO	COURTS/COURT REPORTERS Repeals the provisions of law establishing a court reporter pool employed by the supreme court
HB 188	MUSCARELLO	COURTS/COURT REPORTERS Provides for digital and remote court reporting

HB 782	BRASS	FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS Provides relative to vapor products and alternative nicotine products
HB 911	MCKIN	PARISH/ORLEANS Provides for the complete reform and modernization of the judicial components of Orleans Parish
HB 916	MUSCARELLO	CLERKS OF COURT Provides for an additional filing fee for recordation of documents with the clerk of court
