<b>HB 357</b>	<b>ECHOLS</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides for the adoption of a medical fee reimbursement schedule for workers' compensation
<b>HB 421</b>	<b>COX</b>	<b>LABOR</b> Provides relative to the use of automated decision systems with respect to employment decisions
<b>HB 422</b>	<b>MCKIN</b>	<b>LABOR</b> Enacts the Behind the Counter Safety Act
<b>HB 456</b>	<b>CHENEVERT</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to claims for benefits under workers' compensation
<b>HB 537</b>	<b>CREWS</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Repeals the Workers' Compensation Advisory Council
<b>HB 549</b>	<b>BERAULT</b>	<b>WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT</b> Creates the Bayou Growth Opportunity Workforce Program
<b>HB 605</b>	<b>BEAULLIEU</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to experience modifiers and subrogation in workers' compensation cases
<b>HB 680</b>	<b>WYBLE</b>	<b>WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT</b> Provides relative to waivers under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act
<b>HB 780</b>	<b>FIRMENT</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to penalties and attorney fees for nonpayment, discontinuance of payment, or failure to consent for a medical treatment for workers' compensation claims, controversion of benefits, and preliminary determination hearings
<b>HB 819</b>	<b>CREWS</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to the medical treatment schedule under workers' compensation
