HB 195	BAYHAM	COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES Prohibits, with exceptions, a public postsecondary education institution from prohibiting a student from possessing self-defense chemical spray on campus
HB 283	NEWELL	SCHOOLS Provides relative to incidents of assault and battery on teachers and other school employees
HB 319	BAYHAM	BOARDS/COMMISSIONS Provides relative to the Louisiana Commission on Civic Education
HB 325	BRASS	TOPS Revises initial academic eligibility requirements for a TOPS-Tech award
HB 407	LARVADAIN	HIGHER EDUCATION Provides relative to initial eligibility requirements for the M.J. Foster Promise Program
HB 448	ADAMS	STUDENT/LOANS-SCHOLARSHIP Authorizes scholarships provided for firefighters injured in the line of duty and spouses of firefighters injured or killed in the line of duty to be used for a master's degree
HB 482	TURNER	TOPS Revises the initial and continuing eligibility requirements for a TOPS-Tech award and raises the award amount at Louisiana Community and Technical College System (LCTCS) institutions
HB 992	FREIBERG	EARLY CHILDHOOD Requires assignment of student identification numbers to children in certain early childhood education programs

HCR 26	CHENEVERT	STUDENT/STANDARDS Requests that the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education incorporate the science of human growth and development into content standards and to provide curriculum and instructional materials on its website
HB 113	PHELPS	SCHOOLS Provides for retroactive application of the uniform 10-point grading scale requirement to the grades of students who were enrolled in the ninth grade during the 2023-2024 school year
HB 380	JOHNSON, TRAVIS	COLLEGES/COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL Authorizes Sowela Technical Community College to establish a pilot program in partnership with a school system to increase awareness of and access to certain training programs
HB 392	BOYD	SCHOOLS Provides relative to requirements for posting suicide hotline information on school websites and student ID cards
HB 476	DICKERSON	SCHOOLS Requires each public secondary school to hang flyers about the Safe Haven Law in restrooms
HB 513	YOUNG	ATHLETICS Provides relative to the name, image, and likeness of intercollegiate and interscholastic athletes
HB 608	CHASSION	ATHLETICS Provides relative to the confidentiality of documents related to an intercollegiate athletics revenue sharing program
HB 682	DICKERSON	VETERANS Authorizes the use of veterans as resource officers at schools
HB 905	WRIGHT	HIGHER EDUCATION Changes the name of the Universities of Louisiana Maritime Academy
HB 987	MCFARLAND	HIGHER EDUCATION Realigns energy-related programs by moving the Louisiana Geological Survey under the Louisiana State University Energy Institute
