HB 288	BOYER	HEALTH CARE/RECORDS Provides for the use of certain medical terminology in medical documentation
HB 373	NEWELL	HEALTH Provides for the Louisiana Cannabis Pilot Program
HB 403	COATES	SMALL BUSINESS Provides for the production of homemade food for sale to the public
HB 420	BERAULT	CHILDREN/DCFS Requires the Department of Children and Family Services to obtain background checks on all employees
HB 783	COATES	HEALTH/LDH Provides relative to the regulation of food and food safety
HB 815	CARVER	VITAL RECORDS/DEATH CERT Provides with respect to which entities are entitled to receive death certificates
HB 895	BOYD	HEALTH/MEDICAL TREATMENT Provides relative to the treatment of sexual assault survivors by hospitals and healthcare providers
HB 931	LANDRY, MANDIE	HEALTH Prohibits a contractor or subcontractor of the Louisiana Pregnancy and Baby Care initiative from conditioning services on religious requirements
HB 933	OWEN, CHARLES	RECORDS/RECORDATION Provides for commemorative birth certificates
HB 949	COATES	HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS Provides relative to the Louisiana State Radiologic Technology Board of Examiners
HB 962	MILLER, D.	NURSES Provides relative to reconstitution of medications for intravenous therapy
HB 971	STAGNI	MEDICAID Provides relative to Medicaid reimbursement for rural health clinics
