<b>HR 237</b>	<b>OWEN, CHARLES</b>	<b>CENSUS</b> Memorializes Congress to enact a provision in the National Defense Authorization Act directing the Department of Defense to provide accurate on-base population counts for the decennial census
<b>HCR 74</b>	<b>BAYHAM</b>	<b>INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS</b> Establishes the Louisiana-United Kingdom Trade Commission
<b>HCR 95</b>	<b>BEAULLIEU</b>	<b>TAX EXEMPTIONS</b> Provides for the adoption of tax exemptions
<b>HB 705</b>	<b>NEWELL</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE POWERS</b> Provides relative to contempt of the legislature
<b>HB 1048</b>	<b>MURRAY</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Provides relative to the early voting period
<b>SCR 23</b>	<b>CATHEY</b>	<b>AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES</b> Creates the Agricultural-Based National Security Priorities Task Force.
<b>SCR 31</b>	<b>STINE</b>	<b>CONGRESS</b> Memorializes Congress to amend the National Voter Registration Act.
<b>SCR 38</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>JOINT RULES</b> Repeals Joint Rule No. 7, relative to the Atchafalaya Basin Program Oversight Committee.
<b>SB 49</b>	<b>SEABAUGH</b>	<b>ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT</b> Removes the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education from the list of party primary elections. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 224</b>	<b>FESI</b>	<b>SCHOOL BOARDS</b> Removes requirement for publication of local notice by school boards under certain circumstances. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 233</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>STATE AGENCIES</b> Establishes the Louisiana Statewide Data Exchange Compact. (gov sig)

<b>SB 307</b>	<b>EDMONDS</b>	<b>PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS</b> Authorizes the educational display of the Ten Commandments as a historical document and monument. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 319</b>	<b>PRESSLY</b>	<b>ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for instructions to elections commissioners. (7/1/27)
<b>SB 326</b>	<b>ABRAHAM</b>	<b>CONTRACTORS</b> Provides relative to the State Licensing Board for Contractors. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 387</b>	<b>BASS</b>	<b>HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE</b> Provides relative to pharmacy benefit managers. (1/1/27)
<b>SB 401</b>	<b>TALBOT</b>	<b>PHARMACEUTICALS</b> Provides for a Prescription Drug Affordability Board. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 435</b>	<b>MYERS</b>	<b>CHILDREN</b> Establishes the Commission on Fatherhood Engagement. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 495</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Provides for campaign finance disclosures. (8/1/26)
