III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Bill No. 10 by Representative Pearson

Representative Pearson presented House Bill No. 10, which authorizes a member of the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana to purchase credit for service as a teacher at an out-of-state nonpublic school.

Ms. Maureen Westgard, director, representing Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana, 8401 United Plaza Boulevard, Baton Rouge, LA 70804, (225) 925-6454, spoke in support of House Bill No. 10.

Representative Ourso offered a motion to report House Bill No. 10 favorably, to which Representative Jones objected. A roll call vote was taken and House Bill No. 10 was reported favorably by a vote of 10 yeas and 2 nays. Representatives Pearson, Lorusso, Hoffmann, Hollis, Ivey, Miller, Ourso, Price, Reynolds, and Talbot voted yea. Representatives Jones and Montoucet voted nay.

House Bill No. 45 by Representative Pearson

Representative Pearson presented House Bill No. 45, which provides relative to implementation of new age sixty-two retirement eligibility for new hires in state systems.

Five persons completed witness cards in support of House Bill No. 45 but declined to speak.

Representative Ivey offered a motion to report House Bill No. 45 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 45 was reported favorably by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Pearson, Lorusso, Hoffmann, Hollis, Ivey, Jones, Miller, Montoucet, Ourso, Price, Reynolds, and Talbot voted yea.

Retirement April 22, 2015

House Bill No. 27 by Representative Miller

Representative Miller presented House Bill No. 27, which provides relative to receipt of deferred retirement benefits from the Clerks of Court Retirement and Relief Fund for members first hired on or after January 1, 2011.

Three persons completed witness cards in support of House Bill No. 27 but declined to speak.

Representative Ourso offered a motion to report House Bill No. 27 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 27 was reported favorably by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Pearson, Lorusso, Hoffmann, Jones, Miller, Montoucet, Ourso, Price, Reynolds, and Talbot voted yea.

House Bill No. 44 by Representative Miller

Representative Miller presented House Bill No. 44, which requires employers who terminate participation in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System to pay the portion of the system's unfunded accrued liability attributable to the employer's participation in the system.

Mr. Randy Roche, representing Municipal Police Employees Retirement System, 7722 Office Park Boulevard, Baton Rouge, LA 70809, (225) 929-7411, spoke in favor of the bill.

Representative Pearson offered amendments that requires MPERS board to hire a chief investment officer. Requires the CIO to be an employee of the system who reports directly to the board. Authorizes the MPERS board to establish the required academic and professional qualifications for such position.

Representative Pearson offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Pearson, Lorusso, Hoffmann, Jones, Miller, Montoucet, Ourso, Price, Reynolds, and Talbot voted yea.

Four persons completed witness cards in support of House Bill No. 44 but declined to speak.

Representative Jones offered a motion to report House Bill No. 44 with amendments. Without objection, House Bill No. 44 was reported with amendments by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Pearson, Lorusso, Hoffmann, Jones, Miller, Montoucet, Ourso, Price, Reynolds, and Talbot voted yea.

House Bill No. 56 by Representative Hoffmann

Representative Hoffmann presented House Bill No. 56, which provides relative to modification of employer contribution rates by the board of trustees of the District Attorneys' Retirement System.
