III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Resolution No. 155 by Representative Hoffmann

On behalf of Representative Hoffmann, Representative Hensgens presented House Resolution No. 155, which requests a study and report on tax-related and health-related issues associated with vapor products and electronic cigarettes.

Representative Cox offered a motion to report House Resolution No. 155 favorably. Without objection, House Resolution No. 155 was reported favorably by a vote of 9 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bagley, Chaney, Cox, Horton, LeBas, Pope, Richard, Stagni, and Hensgens voted yea.

There were no witness cards submitted in support, opposition, nor for information.

House Concurrent Resolution No. 61 by Representative Norton

Representative Norton presented House Concurrent Resolution No. 61, which creates the Louisiana Bullying Awareness and Treatment Task Force.

Representative Jackson offered a motion to report House Concurrent Resolution No. 61 favorably. Without objection, House Concurrent Resolution No. 61 was reported favorably by a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bagley, Chaney, Cox, Horton, Hunter, Jackson, Moreno, Pope, Richard, Stagni, and Hensgens voted yea.

House Resolution No. 156 by Representative Hunter

Representative Hunter presented House Resolution No. 156, which requests state-level collaboration to evaluate the issues and conditions of drinking water treatment and distribution in communities throughout Louisiana.

- 1. Change the requirement to evaluate the conditions of each water utility system to a requirement to evaluate the sanitary survey results for each system.
- 2. Change the reporting deadline to 2020.
- 3. Require interim progress reports.

Representative Jackson offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bagley, Chaney, Cox, Horton, Hunter, Jackson, LeBas, Moreno, Pope, Richard, Stagni, and Hensgens voted yea.

Representative Hunter offered a motion to report House Resolution No. 156 with amendments. Without objection, House Resolution No. 156 was reported with amendments by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bagley, Chaney, Cox, Horton, Hunter, Jackson, LeBas, Moreno, Pope, Richard, Stagni, Hensgens, and Hoffmann voted yea.
