III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Bill No. 127 by Representative Mack

Representative Mack presented House Bill No. 127, which repeals the prohibition on issuing warning citations for violations of motor vehicle laws.

Representative Pope offered a motion to report House Bill No. 127 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 127 was reported favorably by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays.
