To discuss and consider the secretary of state's determination and reasons therfor that the public health emergency caused by COVID-19 impairs the 2020 presidential preference primary election and the 2020 municipal general election to the extent that an emergency election plan is necessary to ensure maximum citizen participation in the elections

R. Kyle Ardoin, secretary of state, P.O. Box 94125, Baton Rouge, LA 70804, (225) 922-2880, discussed why the emergency election plan is necessary for the 2020 presidential primary election and the 2020 municipal general election and provided handouts, which are in the committee records, as follows:

Ashley Shelton, Power Coalition, 13929 Kimbleton Avenue, Baton Rouge, LA 70817, (225) 802-2435, spoke in support of the secretary of state's emergency election plan.

Representative Duplessis offered a motion to concur in certification of an emergency. Without objection, the motion passed by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Dwight, Wilford Carter, Duplessis, Farnum, Henry, Ivey, Mike Johnson, Magee, Newell, and White voted yea.

Representative Dwight offered a motion to voluntarily defer action on the written emergency plan for the elections. Without objection, the motion passed by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Dwight, Wilford Carter, Duplessis, Farnum, Henry, Ivey, Mike Johnson, Magee, Newell, and White voted yea.
