III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Bill No. 41 by Representative Larvadain

Representative Larvadain presented House Bill No. 41, which provides relative to the use of tax increment financing in Rapides Parish.

Representative Larvadain distributed a letter from the office of the mayor of Alexandria, the Honorable Jeffrey W. Hall, P.O. Box 71, Alexandria, LA 71309-0071, (318) 449-5000, who requested an amendment to include the executive branch of the city of Alexandria as a governing authority of the tax increment financing district described in House Bill No. 41. Mayor Hall's letter indicated his full support of House Bill No. 41 with the inclusion of such an amendment. The letter is included in the records of this meeting, labeled Exhibit A.

Chairman Huval allowed distribution of an email from Robert Kennedy Hughes, 3-H Investments, Alexandria, LA, (318) 447-8468, in opposition to House Bill No. 41, which is included in the records of this meeting, labeled Exhibit B.

Representative Edmonds offered a motion to voluntarily defer action on House Bill No. 41. Without objection, action on House Bill No. 41 was voluntarily deferred by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Huval, Edmonds, Farnum, Fontenot, Freiberg, Gadberry, Kerner, Lyons, McKnight, Newell, Schamerhorn, and Willard voted yea.

House Bill No. 22 by Representative Stagni

Representative Stagni presented House Bill No. 22, which provides relative to the civil service status of employees of the Kenner Housing Authority.

Representative McKnight offered a motion to report House Bill No. 22 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 22 was reported favorably by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays.
