## **III. BUSINESS**

#### Senate Bill No. 472 by Senator Milligan

Senator Milligan presented Senate Bill No. 472, which prohibits contracts with certain foreignowned companies in connection with critical infrastructure.

Representative Edmonds offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 472 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 472 was reported favorably by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Zeringue, Adams, Bacala, Carrier, Edmonds, Freeman, Hughes, Illg, Kerner, Marcelle, McFarland, Romero, and Turner voted yea.

## House Bill No. 498 by Representative Green

Representative Green presented House Bill No. 498, a constitutional amendment which provides for timing and duration of regular legislative sessions.

Representative Marcelle offered a motion to report House Bill No. 498 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 498 was reported favorably by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Zeringue, Adams, Bacala, Carrier, Edmonds, Freeman, Hughes, Illg, Kerner, Marcelle, McFarland, Romero, and Turner voted yea.

## Senate Bill No. 63 by Senator Mizell

Senator Mizell presented Senate Bill No. 63, which provides for the duties of the Department of Children and Family Services regarding victims of child sex trafficking.

Representative Hughes offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 63 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 63 was reported favorably by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Zeringue, Adams, Bacala, Carrier, Edmonds, Freeman, Hughes, Illg, Kerner, Marcelle, McFarland, Romero, and Turner voted yea.

#### Senate Bill No. 178 by Senator Fields

On behalf of Senator Fields, Dr. Sujuan Boutte, executive director, Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance (LOSFA), 602 North Fifth Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70802, (225) 219-7294, presented Senate Bill No. 178, which provides for TOPS exceptions due to Hurricane Ida.

Representative Marcelle offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 178 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 178 was reported favorably by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Zeringue, Adams, Bacala, Carrier, Edmonds, Freeman, Hughes, Illg, Kerner, Marcelle, McFarland, Romero, and Turner voted yea.

#### Senate Bill No. 235 by Senator Allain

On behalf of Senator Allain, Representative Beaullieu presented Senate Bill No. 235, which authorizes parishes to contract with the Louisiana Sales and Use Tax Commission for Remote Sellers for the collection of local sales and use tax.

Representative Bacala offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 235 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 235 was reported favorably by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Zeringue, Adams, Bacala, Carrier, Edmonds, Freeman, Hughes, Illg, Kerner, Lyons, McFarland, Romero, and Turner voted yea.
