House Bill No. 14 by Representative Schexnayder

On behalf of Representative Schexnayder, Representative Stefanski presented House Bill No. 14, which provides for the districts for the election of members to the House of Representatives.

Representative Stefanski offered amendments to make changes to districts 1, 7, 39, 44, 45, 47, 48, 49, 80, 82, and 96. Representative Stefanski offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 16 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Stefanski, Beaullieu, Wilford Carter, Deshotel, Duplessis, Gadberry, Hodges, Horton, Jenkins, Mike Johnson, LaCombe, Lyons, Magee, Newell, Thomas, and White voted yea.

Representative Stefanski offered a motion to voluntarily defer action on House Bill No. 14. Without objection, action on House Bill No. 14 was voluntarily deferred by a vote of 16 yeas and 0 nays.
