House Bill No. 15 by Representative Hollis

Without objection, action on House Bill No. 15 was voluntarily deferred by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Gregory Miller, Amedee, Boyd, Robby Carter, Echols, Garofalo, Hodges, Jefferson, Jenkins, Mike Johnson, Knox, and Nelson voted yea.

House Bill No. 142 by Representative Beaullieu

Representative Beaullieu presented House Bill No. 142, which provides for the termination of custodial property under the Uniform Transfers to Minors Act.

Representative Echols offered a motion to report House Bill No. 142 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 142 was reported favorably by a vote of 14 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Gregory Miller, Amedee, Boyd, Robby Carter, Echols, Frieman, Garofalo, Jefferson, Jenkins, Mike Johnson, Knox, Muscarello, Nelson, and Seabaugh voted yea.
