III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Resolution No. 152 by Representative Deshotel

Representative Deshotel presented House Resolution No. 152, which directs the Louisiana Department of Health to amend its administrative rule relative to the geographic location of a hospice provider.

Representatives Bagley, Adams, Cox, Crews, Echols, Hughes, Larvadain, McMahen, Dustin Miller, Moore, Pressly, Stagni, and Turner voted yea.
