III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Bill No. 137 by Representative Fisher

Representative Fisher presented House Bill No. 137, which provides relative to the secretary of the municipal fire and police civil service board for the city of Monroe.

Representative Freiberg offered a motion to report House Bill No. 137 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 137 was reported favorably by a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Edmonds, DuBuisson, Fontenot, Freiberg, Gadberry, Kerner, Lyons, Newell, Schamerhorn, Stagni, and Willard voted yea.

House Bill No. 356 by Representative Fisher

Representative Fisher presented House Bill No. 356, which provides relative to compensation for Ouachita Parish hospital service district commission members.

Representative Willard offered a motion to report House Bill No. 356 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 356 was reported favorably by a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays. Representative Edmonds offered amendments to restore present law provisions to clarify that the authority may receive appropriations from the legislature and financial assistance, guarantees, insurance, or subsidies from the federal or state government or a private source. Representative Edmonds offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Edmonds, DuBuisson, Fontenot, Freiberg, Gadberry, Kerner, Lyons, Newell, Schamerhorn, Stagni, and Willard voted yea.

- (1) Exempt public property and property owned by nonprofits from the parcel fee if such property is exempt from ad valorem taxes pursuant to present constitution; and
- (2) Add condominiums to the list of properties subject to a parcel fee not to exceed \$250 per year.

Representative Edmonds offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Edmonds, DuBuisson, Freiberg, Gadberry, Glover, Kerner, Lyons, Newell, Schamerhorn, Stagni, and Willard voted yea.

Representative Newell offered a motion to report House Bill No. 296 with amendments. Without objection, House Bill No. 296 was reported with amendments by a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Edmonds, DuBuisson, Freiberg, Gadberry, Glover, Kerner, Lyons, Newell, Schamerhorn, Stagni, and Willard voted yea.

House Bill No. 185 by Representative Hilferty

Representative Hilferty presented House Bill No. 185, which provides relative to the Lake Terrace Crime Prevention District in Orleans Parish.

Representative Willard offered a motion to report House Bill No. 185 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 185 was reported favorably by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Edmonds, DuBuisson, Farnum, Freiberg, Gadberry, Glover, Kerner, Lyons, Newell, Schamerhorn, Stagni, and Willard voted yea.

Representative Bourriaque presented House Bill No. 209, which provides relative to Cameron Parish Water and Wastewater Board for District No. 1.

Representative Stagni offered a motion to report House Bill No. 209 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 209 was reported favorably by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Edmonds, DuBuisson, Farnum, Freiberg, Glover, Kerner, Newell, Schamerhorn, Stagni, and Willard voted yea.

House Bill No. 114 by Representative Orgeron

Representative Orgeron presented House Bill No. 114, which exempts certain state property in Lafourche Parish from state park size requirements.
