III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Bill No. 264 by Representative Deshotel

Representative Deshotel presented House Bill No. 264, which designates a bridge located on Louisiana Highway 1 in Pointe Coupee in Avoyelles, Louisiana, as the "Marion Peter Roy, Sr. Bridge".

Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays.
