House Bill No. 2 by Representative Bishop

Representative Bishop presented House Bill No. 2, which provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget.

Representative Bishop offered amendments which changes General Obligation Bond funding as follows:

Representative Bishop offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 17 yeas and 0 nays. Representative Bishop offered a motion to report House Bill No. 2 with amendments. Without objection, House Bill No. 2 was reported with amendments by a vote of 17 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bishop, Beaullieu, Bourriaque, Bryant, Butler, DeVillier, Farnum, LaCombe, Landry, McMahen, Mincey, Orgeron, Phelps, Riser, Schlegel, White, and Willard voted yea.

Representative Bishop offered a motion to authorize staff to make necessary technical corrections on any adopted amendments on House Bill No. 2. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 17 yeas and 0 nays.
