III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

Senate Bill No. 97 by Senator Pressly

Senator Pressly presented Senate Bill No. 97, which creates the Coordinated Use of Resources for Recreation, Economy, Navigation, and Transportation Authority.

Dustin H. Davidson, DENR, 617 N. Third Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70802, spoke for information only on Senate Bill No. 97.

Stephen Swiber, Office of the Governor, 900 N. Third Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70801, spoke for information only on Senate Bill No. 97.

Representative Chassion offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 97 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 97 was reported favorably by a vote of 8 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bourriaque, Boyer, Chassion, Moore, Schamerhorn, Spell, Tarver, and Wiley voted yea.

Senate Bill No. 216 by Senator Hodges

Senator Hodges presented Senate Bill No. 216, which authorizes the Department of Transportation and Development to use certain bidding processes.

Representative Chassion offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 216 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 216 was reported favorably by a vote of 8 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bourriaque, Boyer, Chassion, Moore, Schamerhorn, Spell, Tarver, and Wiley voted yea.

Senate Bill No. 166 by Senator Womack

On behalf of Senator Womack, Representative Bourriaque presented Senate Bill No. 166, which provides relative to contract requirements for public works.

Representative Tarver offered amendments to:

- (1) Remove the appropriate state agency as a required participant in the preconstruction meeting.
- (2) Require participation by the local governmental entity, the contractor, and the design professional of record, with notice to the appropriate state entity.

Representative Tarver offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 8 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bourriaque, Boyer, Chassion, Moore, Schamerhorn, Spell, Tarver, and Wiley voted yea.

Representative Chassion offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 166 with amendments. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 166 was reported with amendments by a vote of 8 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bourriaque, Boyer, Chassion, Moore, Schamerhorn, Spell, Tarver, and Wiley voted yea.
