III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

Senate Bill No. 389 by Senator Connick

On behalf of Senator Connick, Larry Frieman, chief deputy attorney general, 1885 North Third Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70802, appearing as the designee of the attorney general, presented Senate Bill No. 389, which provides for agents and athletes.

Olivia Nuss, assistant attorney general, 1885 N. 3rd St., Baton Rouge, LA 70802, spoke as a designee of the attorney general in support of Senate Bill No. 389.

Representative Muscarello offered an amendment to make technical changes. Representative Muscarello offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendment. Without objection, the amendment was adopted by a vote of 7 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Muscarello, Carlson, Chenevert, Edmonston, Glorioso, Mike Johnson, and Taylor voted yeas.

John T. Curtis, John Curtis Christian School, 10125 Jefferson Hwy., River Ridge, LA 70123, spoke in support of Senate Bill No. 389.

Representative Edmonston offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 389 with amendments. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 389 was reported with amendments by a vote of 8 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Muscarello, Carlson, Chenevert, Edmonston, Glorioso, Mike Johnson, Melerine, and Taylor voted yeas.

Senate Bill No. 525 by Senator Morris

At the request of Senator Morris, Representative Muscarello offered a motion to voluntarily defer action on Senate Bill No. 525, which requires unclaimed property purchase agreements to include certain information. Without objection, action on Senate Bill No. 525 was voluntarily deferred by a vote of 8 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Muscarello, Carlson, Chenevert, Edmonston, Glorioso, Mike Johnson, Melerine, and Taylor voted yeas.
