HOUSE BILL NO. 1—

BY REPRESENTATIVE FANNIN AN ACT

Making annual appropriations for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 for the ordinary expenses of the executive branch of state government, pensions, public schools, public roads, public charities, and state institutions and providing with respect to the expenditure of said appropriations.

Read by title.

Rep. James sent up committee amendments which were read as follows:

On page 64, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following:

"Payable out of the State General Fund by Interagency Transfers from the Executive Department, Executive Office to the Operational Support Program for costs incurred for state troopers traveling with the governor out of the state

"Provided, however, that the Department of Health and Hospitals is directed to conform the eligibility standards of the Medicaid program administered by the state to the minimum standards provided in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111-148). The secretary of the department may implement the expansion of the Medicaid program in a manner that is the same as or substantially similar to any state expansion program already approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services which allows newly eligible Medicaid beneficiaries to acquire insurance policies from private insurers.

The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to utilize any State General Fund (Direct) realized from the expansion of eligibility in the Medicaid program as provided in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act for the purpose of making payments to partner hospitals. Further, the commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to transfer funding between programs to ensure that the budget unit shall fully utilize

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and maximize State General Fund (Direct) funding as a result of any savings realized from the expansion of eligibility as provided in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act for the purpose of making payments to partner hospitals."

Rep. Edwards moved the adoption of the amendments.
