Suspension of the Rules

Rep. Henry moved to suspend Rule 6.25 to consider House Bill No. 1 schedule by schedule, which motion was agreed to.

HOUSE BILL NO. 1—

BY REPRESENTATIVE HENRY

AN ACT

Making annual appropriations for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 for the ordinary expenses of the executive branch of state government, pensions, public schools, public roads, public charities, and state institutions and providing with respect to the expenditure of said appropriations.

Read by title.

Rep. Stokes sent up committee amendments which were read as follows:

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE HOUSE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Stokes in the Committee of the Whole House to Engrossed House Bill No. 1 by Representative Henry

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 89, between lines 30 and 31, insert the following:

"Payable out of the State General Fund by Fees and Self-generated Revenues to the Tax Collection Program for participation in any Multistate Tax Commission Project that the secretary of the department certifies is designed to increase collections through multistate cooperation on arms-length adjustments

\$ 150,000"

"Provided, however, that no monies appropriated herein shall be used to support any activity which involves the making of a rebate payment for a claim for a rebate received in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 submitted by a person or other entity that is not a resident of or headquartered in Louisiana if the payment exceeds the person or entity's Louisiana income tax liability for the taxable period for which the rebate is claimed."

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 105, between lines 17 and 18, insert the following:

"Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct) to Louisiana State University Board of Supervisors for Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center - Shreveport for operating expenses

\$ 37, 390,653

Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct) to Louisiana State University Board of Supervisors for Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center - New Orleans for operating expenses

\$ 3,977,212"

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In Committee of the Whole House Amendment No. 2 by Representative Jackson (#4374) that amended page 103, on page 3, line 32, change "71,930,619" to "35,965,309"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In Committee of the Whole House Amendment No. 1 by Representative Jackson (#4374), on page 3, between lines 25 and 26, insert the following:

"The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and directed to adjust the means of financing from the funding for public private partner hospitals itemized above by reducing the appropriation out of the State General Fund (Direct) by \$35,965,309. Such reduction shall be allocated to each hospital on a pro rata basis of the itemized funding above. The commissioner of administration is further authorized to adjust other means of financing only to the extent necessary as a result of achieving the reduction."
