HOUSE BILL NO. 1— BY REPRESENTATIVE ZERINGUE

AN ACT
To appropriate funds for Fiscal Year 2022-2023, relative to the Insure Louisiana Incentive Program; to impose restrictions on the use of such appropriation; to require reports relative to the use of such appropriation; to direct the state treasurer to transfer certain sums into the program fund for the execution of the appropriation; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 1 by Representative Zeringue

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 26, after ""A"." delete the remainder of the line in its entirety and on page 2 delete lines 1 and 2 in their entirety and at the beginning of line 3 delete "policies in Louisiana, such insurer" and insert in lieu thereof "Any nonadmitted insurer applying for a grant pursuant to the Insure Louisiana Incentive Program"

HOUSE BILL NO. 2-

BY REPRESENTATIVE STEFANSKI AN ACT

On page 1, at the end of line 17, delete "The" and delete lines 18 and 19 in their entirety and after line 19 insert "The Department of Insurance shall promulgate rules for the implementation and execution of this restriction."
